## A day full of surprizes Armenia new leader

**I**t seems that the rest day was very usefull, at least for all the teams from the top. If You remember that in round five first 5 matches ended in 2:2, today there was no such a result in first 14 matches!

The heroes of the day were Dutch players. They defeated Russia with 2,5:1,5. It could have been even worse for leaders, since Grišchuk was a pawn down for a long time, but finally managed to escape in a rook end-game. The only decided game was on bord four, where Nijboer outplayed Rublevsky in a highly tactical game. With such a result Netherlands is now second with 17,5 points, while Russia dropped behind with half a point less.

After yesterday's round we have a new leader! It is Armenia, who defeated Uzbekistan with 2,5:1,5, thanks to the victory of Akopian against Barsov, while all other games ended in a draw.

Another surprise in top matches was created by Belarus. They won 3:1 against higher rated team of Spain. Especially important was Aleksandrov's win against Shirov on board number 1. They are now on 17 points, together with Russia.

Four other winners in top matches are half a point behind: Ukraine, USA, Sweden and India. While USA, Sweden and especially India are certainly very satisfied with their result, we are sure that Ukraine expected more from their match against Iran, who continues to surprize. Actual champions managed to win just one game and it was Elyanov on board three. Sweden and USA won with the same small result against Bulgaria and China, while India managed to cash even 3 points against Germany. After their disastrous start they are now sharing fifth place already.

Italian «A» team lost to Lithuania with 1,5:2,5, «C» team lost with the same result against Chile, while only «B» team managed to give some joy to italian fans by scoring 3,5 points against Faroe Islands.

The situation on the top is now: Armenia 18,0 points, Netherlands 17,5, Russia and Belarus 17,0 followed by Ukraine, USA, Sweden and India with 16,5 points.

One more interesting detail is that only two teams won all their matches and these are Belarus and USA!



Top pairings for round seven are: Netherlands-Armenia, Russia-Belarus, India-Ukraine and USA-Sweden.

We feel somehow that today it will be a real fireworks on boards!

More or less the same scenario was seen by women as well - 11 decided matches from first 12! Two leading teams, Russia and Ukraine, won with the same result 2:1. Their victims were Hungary and Spain. Ukraine missed a chance at least to equalize their number of points with Russia. They are now on 14,5 and respectively 14,0 points.

A surprizingly high victory (3.0) of Slovakia against Lithuania brought them to the third place with 13,5 points. It seems that

Lithuanians collapsed after their short moments of glory a couple of rounds ago.

Four teams are on 13,0 points: USA, Romania, India and Bulgaria. They all won their matches with the same 2:1 result. Their victims were Mongolia, Armenia, Slovenia and Kazakhstan. Three teams follow with half a point less: Hungary, China and Estonia. The only team who won all the matches is Ukraine.

Top pairings for round seven are: Slovakia-Russia, Ukraine-Romania, USA-India, Bulgaria-China and Estonia-Hungary.

Today we step into the second half of this tournament and the suspense is growing up! (M.Cebalo)

**A**fter the success of the website, the stands at the Chess Olympiad start filling up Tickets for the parterre sold out and reprinted

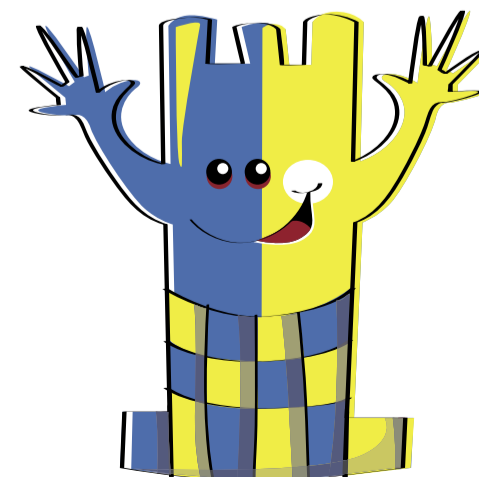

# Interview with Michele Godena

**M**ichele Godena, age 39, GM and present national champion, is the Italian player with the highest Elo rating (2537). After today's hard fought game he gave us this short interview.

*How many Olympiads did you take part in?*

I attended the last 10 Olympiads, Turin included, starting in Thessaloniki in 1988, and since Moscow 1994 I have played in the first board. Actually today's game has been the 100th in my Olympiads.

*Are Olympiads different from normal tournaments?*

Definitely yes. The number of participants is extraordinarily higher, and you meet people from all over the world. You really understand what "Gens una sumus" means.

*And what about the training for this kind of tournament?*

This should be different too. Ideally you should have a number of training stages with all the team players, in order not only to work on the technical aspects, but also to improve the team spirit. But unfortunately this has been possible only once before the event.

*How is the Olympiad going so far?*

We could have scored better, even if we have met strong teams. Personally I can be satisfied at the moment: in the first board I have played four games, winning one and drawing three. And against Smirin (Israel, 2662) and Rozentalis (Lithuania, 2596) I probably had a better position with black, though their rating is higher is mine. But I am sorry for Garcia Palermo, who lost two games that were likely won. He just needs a good result to recover confidence and shape, so to show what is his actual skill.

# Three women amongst the men

**O**ne of the curiosities of the Turin Chess Olympiad is the presence of women players in men's teams (men, on the other hand, may not play in women's teams). Three men's teams (Hong Kong, Bermuda and Monte Carlo) are playing women players, and in two cases the woman in question is actually on top board.

The Hong Kong team has the fifteen-year-old Anya Corke (born September 1990) on top board. Anya is one of the strongest under-16s in the world and was overall champion (i.e. including both men and women) of Hong Kong at just 14, so becoming the second youngest national champion of all time (the absolute youngest was none other than Capablanca who became champion of Cuba at the age of just 12).

On the Bermuda team we have Zuzana Kovacova on top board who in the first five games has clocked up 3 and half points (3 wins, a draw and a loss).

Fourth board on the Monte Carlo (Monaco) team is Julia Lebel-Arias.

# Game of the day

**Kasimdzhanov Rustam (2673)**  
**Ivanchuk Vasyl (2731)**

If White goes now 8.c3 he allows Black to enter in Marshall Attack, one of the sharpest lines in Spanish game. The most funny thing is that very often in such a case Black chooses to transpose to the main line with 8...d6 instead of 8...d5. On the other hand a lot of players with White prefer to avoid this line with some "antimarshall" moves which will happen in our game as well. The conclusion might be that it is not so easy to say who is more afraid to enter this line! **8.h3** One of the ways to avoid Marshall Gambit (or Marshall Attack). White can do the same with: [8.d3; or 8.a4.] **8...d6 9.c3** Now we are back in the main line. **9...Bb7 10.d4 Re8 11.Nbd2 Bf8 12.a4 h6** The evolution of this variation can be followed in the best way by looking at the games played between Kasparov and Karpov, during years of their rivalry. 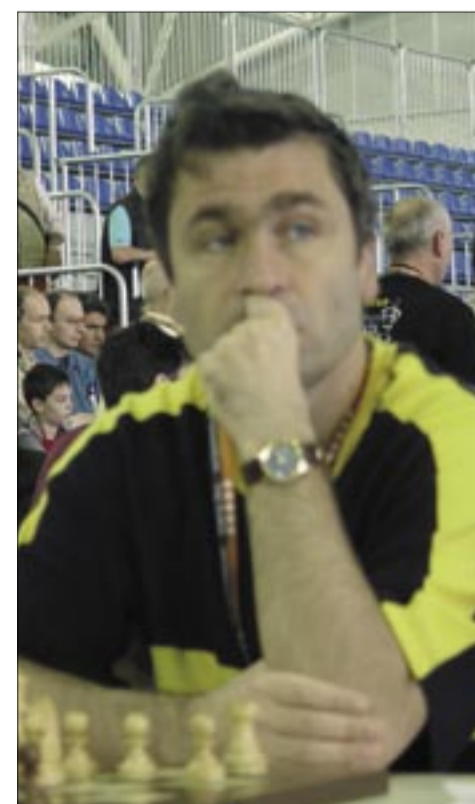

**27...Rxe4!** The only chance to stay in the game. White was already threatening black queen (28.Rxf8+). **28.Bxh6** [28.Bxe4?! Qxe4 would give Black more than a full compensation for exchange.] **28...Ra7** [28...Rae8 29.Be3 Be7 with the idea to put the bishop on f6 in order to secure an emergency exit for the king was better, because in that case White would have not been able to exchange his darksquared bishop for the knight.] **29.Bd2 Rf7 30.Bxe4 Qxe4 31.Rfh3 Rf5** [31...Qc4+ 32.Kg1 doesn't change much.] **32.Bxb4 Qxb4 33.Qe2 Qc4** The only way to avoid mating threats is to enter in this difficult endgame. **34.Qxc4 bxc4 35.Rh5 Rxh5?** This loses by force, because Black now cannot defend his a pawn. [The only chance was 35...g5 36.Rh8+ Kf7 37.R1h7+ Bg7 where White probably has nothing better than 38.Rd8 Kg6 39.Rxg7+ Kxg7 40.Rxd6 with good chances to win such a rook endgame.] **36.Rxh5 Be7 37.Rh3!** White finds the most accurate plan. **37...Bf6 38.b3! c3 39.Ke2 Kf7 40.Kd3** Now the rook is ready to go for "a" pawn. **40...Kg6 41.Rh8 Kf5 42.Ra8 Ke5 43.Rxa6 Kxd5 44.a5 g6 45.Ra7 Kc6 46.Rf7** And there is nothing to do anymore against the promotion of the "a" pawn. **46...Kd5** 1-0 (M.Cebalo).

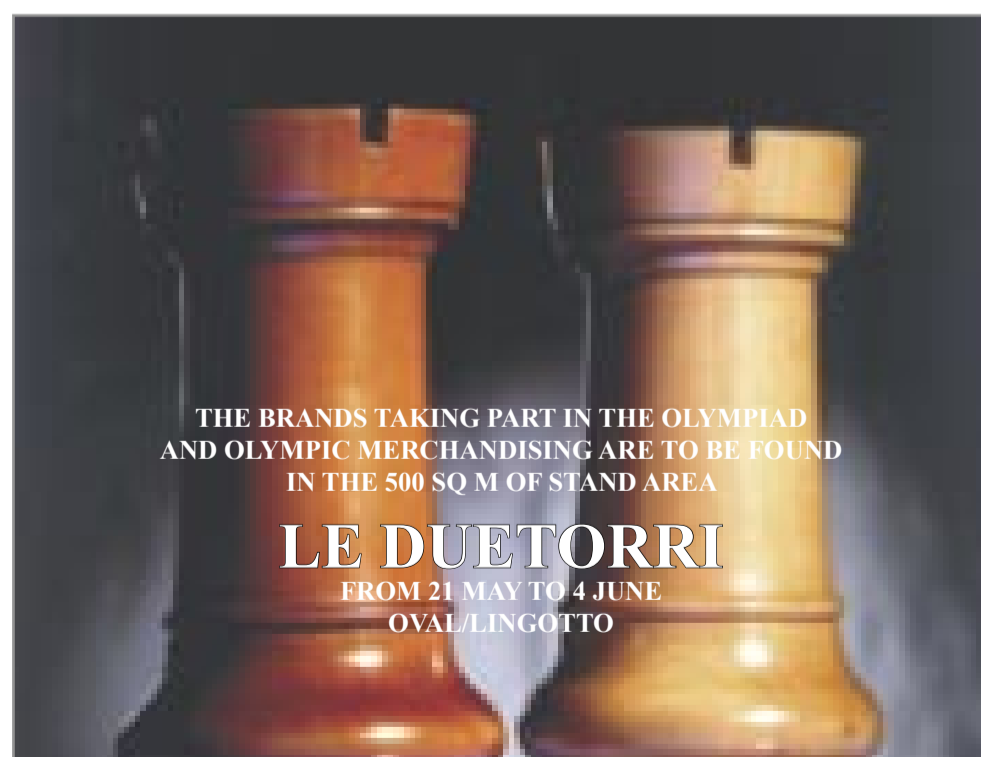
