USA defeats Russian team

One more win from Armenia, this time 3:1 against Czech Republic, risks already to take away any suspense in the battle for gold. The gap is already 3,5 points. The match was practically decided after two hours of play, when Navara overlooked a diabolical tactics. Another full point was made by Asrian this time, while other two games ended in a draw.

France defeated China with 2,5:1,5 and joined them on the second place. Three games ended in a draw, while French hero of the day was Lautier who won against Zhang Zhong with White on board number two.

Another great match was USA-Russia. Americans won 2,5:1,5, thanks to Nakamura who was the only non-Russian player in this encounter. His victim was Grischuk, while other three games ended in a draw. Russia risks now to miss the podium.

Cuba defeated Uzbekistan 2,5:1,5 and joined the top group, Ukraine cashed three points against Azerbaijan, as did Israel against India. Romania with Georgia and Hungary with Denmark played 2:2.

Italian derby ended in 2:2 as well. It seems that «B» team was closer to win this match. Italia «C» won against Zambia 2,5:1,5.

The situation on the top is now: Armenia 32,0, China and France 28,5, Russia and USA 28,0, Ukraine, Israel, Cuba and Czech Republic 27,5 and so on.

Top pairings for round twelve are: France-Armenia, Czech Republic-China, Russia-Cuba, Israel-Usa and Ukraine-Netherlands.



In the last two rounds we shall see a dramatic fight for remaining two places on the podium – seven candidates are on 1 point distance only.

By women the most important things happened in first three matches. Ukraine won against Bulgaria with 2,5:0,5, only Stefanova managed to make draw, and now is one point ahead of Russia who won against Georgia 2:1. A decisive step toward podium was made by China. They cashed all three points against Greece.

Two more important victories were achieved by India, 2:1 against Romania, and USA, 2,5:0,5 against Slovenia. Both of those teams joined the top. One more important match was that between France and Armenia and it ended 1,5:1,5.

Italian teams drew their matches, «A» team against Finland, «B» team against Scotland.

The standing on the top is: Ukraine 25,5, Russia 24,5, China 23,5, USA and India 21,5, Georgia 21,0, Armenia, France and Hungary 20,5 and so on.

It seems that here the medals are already booked, however it is still not clear which colour belongs to whom.

Top pairings for round 12 are: Ukraine-India, Russia-France, Usa-China, Armenia-Georgia and Netherlands-Hungary.

Ukraine is still with perfect score counting match points!

In the run for «Nona Gaprindashvili» trophy there are five candidates: China, Armenia, Ukraine, Russia and France.

Kirsan Ilyumzhinov has been reelected president of Fide for the period 2006/2010 in a crowded General Assembly. Hosted in "Torino Incontra", the most important convention centre of Turin, the Assembly started at 10 in the morning, but vote could only be expressed at 19.30. After a long campaign for presidency started many months ago, which took places also in the exhibition area of Turin Olympiads, Kirsan Ilyumzhinov has beaten Bessel Kok. The result from delegates and presidents has been 96 to 45 for Kirsan. Editorial staff of Turin moves wishes good work for the future of chess.



The Mayor of Turin Sergio Chiamparino has visited the Chess Olympiad venue, welcomed by the enthusiasm of the volunteers, the players and the organizers. The Mayor, while receiving his accreditation, was awarded by Michele Corradi, Managing Director of the Olympiad, a CD containing the Olympic anthem edited by the famous Italian soundtrack writer, Ennio Morricone. The Mayor has then given some interviews and among them also with the Russian Television NTV-Plus, which daily covers the Torino Chess Olympiad with almost one hour live broadcast.

A few statistics

With the end of the tournament coming closer, it could be interesting to explore more in detail the games played so far with the help of some statistics. Their number, indeed, is large enough to allow with some confidence an insight into some features of chess at the beginning of the 21th century.

Let's consider the first ten rounds of the general section, where 2934 games have been actually played, not taking into account default losses and moveless draws. White has won in 39% of the games, black in 31%, with draws accounting for a 30%. The relatively low number of draws suggests that matches were really hard fought, with little if any compromise, and this is indeed confirmed by the feeling one gets looking at what actually happens in the olympic hall. This is somehow due also to the wide range of players levels. The average rating is 2360, but this figure refers to players with an official rating, that means about 90% of them, spanning from 1681 of Murara (Korea) to 2803 of Anand (India).



The average number of moves per game so far has been of 43, the shortest game not drawn being Pacheco-Bachmann (Perù-Paraguay) of 12 moves, and the longest S.Mohammed-Goh Koon Jong (Iraq-Singapore) and Hatanbaatar-Samolins (Mongolia-Latvia) of 127.

More interesting from the player point of view are data on the occurrence of different openings and their results. 1.e4 is clearly the most popular one with a 53% occurrence, while 1.d4 has only 38%, followed by 1.c4 with 6% and others with 3%. At first sight this preference looks justified: wins with 1.e4 account to 40%, while players who have preferred 1.d4 had to be content with a 37%. The other side of the medal, of course, is that 1.e4 involves more risks: black won in the 32% of the games against a 30%, and the draws were

28% against a 33%. Surprisingly the results obtained with 1.c4 are somehow better than those of 1.d4, showing a higher solidity, in spite of the close character of both openings (38% won, 35% draws and 27% lost). All this is current chess wisdom, and if we look at the mean points scored with the three most common first moves we discover that they are fairly similar: 55,4% for 1.c4, 54,2% for 1.e4 and 53,7% for 1.d4. We should need a statistician to know if these tiny differences are significant, but we would rather believe that figures demonstrate that all openings are equivalent and that wins and losses do not depend on the first move.

Let's consider now the main black's defences. Against 1.e4 the best score (48,3%) is obtained with the Sicilian, that is at the same time, deservedly, the most popular defense (24% of all played games). Second comes the French (45,2%), demonstrating its fighting mood, with the Open games on a slightly inferior level (44,4%). Worse performances are recorded by Caro Kann (43,8%), though its supposed rock solidity, and Scandinavian (39,7%), while Pirc/Modern Defence appears to be under pressure, scoring only 38,8%. An excellent performance is recorded by Aljechin defence (53,7%), but the low number of games played makes the statistical analysis less reliable: maybe fashion affects openings more than their actual merits.

In the queen's pawn kingdom things look harder for white, as two defences have scored above the 50%: the King's Indian (52,2%) and the Nimzo Indian (51,0%). A great performance for these highly complex strategical systems, whose occurrence in the tournament (6 and 3%) is oddly much lower than that of Queen's Gambit (15%), though the latter has a much poorer outcome (43,4%). It is curious indeed, that players prefer the aggressive and complex Sicilian variations against 1.e4, while in case of 1.d4 they rather play the solid 1...d5.

50,9% has been the score of miscellaneous minor systems, such as Old Indian and some schemes where white avoid c4, that actually are not so minor, as they account for 4% of all played games. The Dutch and the Benoni scored well too (47,3 and 46,3%) but they are currently not fashionable. More popular, but less successful, look Grunfeld and Queen's Indian (45,7 and 43,1%).

These are of course broad considerations, and a more in depth analysis is clearly required in order to better understand the above figures.

1° prize: Junior!

Dinner in a Turin good restaurant with an amusing premiation for the World Computer Chess Championship.

The Israeli programm Junior, developed by Amir Ban e Shay Bushinsky, has won with 9 (7 wins and 4 draws) on 11 games. This was the second time that Junior had won the championship: the previous occasion was in Ramat Gan (Israel) in 2004. In second place (8,5) was another former World Champion program, Shredder, developed by Stefan Mayer-Khalen in Germany. The 2005 champion, Zappa, this year was only the fourth behind Rajlich (experimental version of Rybka). I ask to Amir: "What do you think about Junior's stren-

ght in relation to Topalov's strength?". The answer was astonishing: "In 2005 I invited Topalov in Bilbao and the result was equal: Junior is enough strong!".

The world computer chess championship is an annual event organised by ICGA (the International Computer Games Association) whose president is the International master David Levy.

Chess and Cinema

From 1 to 4 June the National Cinema Museum is organising "Chess and Movies". The event was presented by Ettore Ridola, author in 1995 of the essay "Dangerous Moves. One hundred years of chess in films" which reviewed this fascinating aspect of cinema from "Entr'acte," which featured Marcel Duchamp and Man Ray, to "Chess Fever", a comic masterpiece made by Sergei Pudovkin during the Moscow tournament of 1925 (with Capablanca as supporting actor playing himself) to the rarely seen "A world of marionettes" by Ingmar Bergman, and more recent films like "The third star" by Alberto Ferrari, which came out in 2004.

The first film presented was "Game Over: Kasparov and the Machine" by Vikram Jayanti (90'; Canada/Great Britain 2003) which really does tell us everything we would have liked to know about the match but had never dared hope would be said: let's just say that IBM doesn't come out of it very well!

The second film was also a formidable achievement: "Stanley and Us" made by three courageous young Italians: Mauro Di Flaviano, Federico Greco and Stefano Landini.

There is substantially no connection between this film and chess and the promise in the presentation of the film of an appearance by GM Larry Evans, master of the great Stanley Kubrick, is nowhere to be seen.

However, for anyone who loves the history of cinema and, in particular, the work of Kubrick, it is indispensable to see this pleasantly engrossing film.

Not only for the wealth of details that it contains about this great American director's way of making films, but above all for an extraordinary series of exciting interviews with people who are close to him for reasons of work, relationships (wife, daughter) or friendship.


